


DEPARTURES FROM JEDA'A 5

Jeddah 5 Departures

- Background
 - Gol closed the Jeddah 5 IDP camp in Ninewa governorate on 18 April
 - DTM activated ET on 20 April to track the departed people based on their location of arrivals
 - Methodology: Phone interviews with families and key informant interviews, including local authorities
- Update as of 29 April:
 - 322 families arrived to 4 governorates, including 101 families who arrived as IDPs and 221 families who returned to their locations of origin
 - Two thirds arrived in Al-Qayara and 13% in Markaz Mosul subdistricts, both in Mosul
 - Top IDP subdistricts of origin: Al-Qayara (23%), Markaz Al-Hatra (20%) and Al Zab (8%)

DTM

- DTM ET update – as of 29 April
 - Shelters
 - Two thirds of families in critical shelters
 - 83% in Al-Qayara
 - 8% in Markaz Mosul
 - Departure letters
 - In over three quarters of locations, no family received a departure letter to facilitate their return
 - Notes from field teams
 - Reports of revenge attacks, including burning of shelters
 - Authorities in Makhmour district do not want to receive these families
 - In Ninewa, security actors are trying to protect the families from incidents
 - Intentions to relocate and redisplacement
